Small group activities

Museum workshops are carried out in the living environment of older people. Journey from the past to the present is inspired by photographs, objects, and stories. Often workshop includes art-based method. Interaction and learning new skills will encourage participants to feel good, positively affecting their well-being. For example, Tatamuri® in Museum is group activity for people with memory disorder and their family members.



Museum packages to lend out

Popular museum packages are a great tool for reminiscence and discussion. A single object, photograph, sound, smell, or surface can create an experience. The range includes 17 different packages. Care homes borrow them for free. The items are packed in handy boxes and suitcases. They come with educational material and tips.



Car Trunk Museum

A small museum exhibition is easy to assemble in the trunk of a car. The exhibits are drawn from the museum's handling collection and photo archive, centered around the themes of leisure and work. The tour stops every summer in the courtyards of care homes across the city. Visitors examine the exhibits up close and tell many stories about their own lives.

Konkarit provides a local museum service for older people in day centres, care homes, clubs and in their own homes in the Tampere area. The museums' collections and exhibitions are used imaginatively to ensure that as many people as possible can enjoy culture and the arts wherever they live.
