# **Development work continues**

The process of preparing the neighbourhood vision brought the residents of the area and other actors together to consider its development: now the work continues towards concrete actions.

This document describes the neighbourhood vision serving the related programme for Kaukajärvi and Annala 2023–2025 and the measures implementing it.

The vision born from extensive background work and several interesting discussions and meetings has a strong regional feel. It is a summary of the dreams and development needs shared by residents and operators to promote Kaukajärvi and Annala. The vision statements and goals encapsulated in the various themes of the vision serve as a compass for the long-term development of the area, in which everyone is welcome to participate.

In the neighbourhood programme, the development of the Kaukajärvi and Annala area will continue until the end of 2025 by co-ordinating the implementation of the operational programme.
